Implementation Plans

This document sets out the implementation plan for the 3 Area Forums and each Sub-Group; - Serious Cases, Quality Assurance and Audit, Development, Policy & Procedures, Training Steering Group and Young People Sexually Exploited & Abused. This document is to be read in conjunction with BSCB Business Plan and the Performance Bulletin, which is currently being developed.

The Implementation plans will be the key delivery mechanism for the business plan, they will also be used to:-

- Assess the effectiveness of the arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people
- Monitor individual agencies contribution and commitment to carry out their safeguarding duties and responsibilities.
- Audit and evaluating how well local services are working together to make Birmingham a safer place for children and young people

All safeguarding members have a crucial role to play in ensuring we deliver on the key activities outlined in these implementation plans.

The Business Co-ordinator, chair and vice chairs, executive groups and local forums and sub-groups have a specific responsibility for driving forward the implementation plans.

The Implementation plans are seen to be a living document focussing, on each sub-groups key-activities that will enable us to deliver on our priority outcomes. The key activities have been given realistic timescales, which allow us to monitor and chart progress. The final column will be used to record the reported task completion and ratification by the Board

The Business Co-ordinator will maintain a strategic overview, through the developing Performance Monitoring Framework, highlighting trends, sharing of good practice and identified areas for further development, providing a quarterly Performance Bulletin which will inform and assist in decision-making at all levels throughout the safeguarding structure.
